II. STUDENT REPORTS

III. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Testing

Bill discussed the new CMAS testing schedule. 7th grade Social Studies and 8th grade Science will be tested in October and again in April. In March and May, grades 6-11 will be tested in Reading, Writing and Math. Each test sequence will consist of three tests of 80 minutes in length each. We will lose 24 days to testing and the May tests conflict with AP testing.

IV. MINUTES

V. BUDGET

Bill handed out the approved budget. We received over \$132,000 in additional allocations for General Ed. By mid-April we will have an additional security officer and next school year we will have a psychologist for two days a week.
