

Lettering in Stagecraft & Design

Lettering in Stagecraft and Design is an honor comparable to schools with sports teams and academics with high standards. High school students may letter once a year – with each year, they may earn a recognition pin and the privilege of purchasing a Stagecraft and Design Tour Jacket, sporting an exclusive S&D design on the back.

To letter in Stagecraft and Design, students must earn 1000 points, determined by the following point scale:

Procedure for Application:

- To apply, the applicant must complete the online application, listing all accomplishments – by director and date.

Notes to Applicants:

- If you think you deserve credit for an accomplishment that is not listed on the above point scaled, feel free to discuss it with the Stagecraft & Design Director.
- Points listed in each category are the maximum that can be awarded; actual points awarded are at the discretion of the Stagecraft & Design Director.
- Points must be earned while the applicant is a student at Denver School of the Arts.
- Points can be earned for non-DSA productions.
- Students can submit an accomplishment only once – not in two different categories.
