USITT Recommended Packing List

Accu Weather For-cast for Fort Lauderdale FL March 13-17,2018 (as of 3/6/18)

- *Tues. 3-13, 73 high 59 low partial sunshine*
- *Wed. 3-14, 77 high 65 low partial sunshine*
- *Thurs. 3-15, 80 high 58 low mostly sunny*
- *Fri. 3-16, 81 high 67 low morning rain*
- *Sat. 3-17 79 high 68 low morning rain*

1. Swim suit/beach towel
2. Sunglasses
3. Sunscreen
4. After sun lotion/aloe vera
5. Hat to protect your face from the sun/rain
6. Comfortable walking shoes
7. Shoes you don't mind getting wet (*Airboat/Beach*)
8. Comfortable light weight clothing (*layers, we will be moving between the outside and air conditioning, mornings & evenings will also be cool*)
9. Jacket (*rain or water resistant would be good*)
10. Toiletries (*see packing specifications below*)
11. Cell phone
12. Phone charger & extra battery
13. Head phones/ear buds
14. Bag/backpack (*for swag ;D*)
15. Debit Card/Cash for food & expenses (*recommended \$200 for food*)
16. Student/State ID and/or driver's license
17. Boarding Pass (*confirmation codes- GX2XM9 & GYQ84Y, check in up to 24 hours ahead of time*)

United Airlines policy for carry-on baggage are as followed:

1. One carry-on bag that should not exceed 45 linear inches (22"x14"x9")
2. One personal bag that should not exceed 36 linear inches (16"x 11" x9")
3. Both items are free and must fit in the overhead bin or the seat in front of you.
4. Any jacket, umbrella, etc... does not count towards your carry-on allowance.

As for packing those bags, TSA advises that planning ahead and packing properly can ease the screening process. You are allowed to bring liquids, aerosols, gels, creams and pastes in containers that are 3.4 ounces or less per item and must be placed in a clear quart-sized bag in your carry-on bags. When going through screening, you will need to be able to remove this bag plus any electronics from your carry-on bags and place them in a separate bin through the x-ray (*Any electronics larger than a cell phone will need to be removed from your bag and placed in bins*).

Know what you can and cannot pack in your carry-on bags. No sharp objects like knives, Leatherman tools, swords, etc... Any type of flammable items. No firearms; real or replicas. (*If it looks like a gun, leave it out of your bag.*) No items that contain THC/marijuana. (*It is still illegal federally*) If you are not sure if the item you want to bring is allowed by TSA, you can go to [TSA.gov](https://www.tsa.gov) and you can find a full list of items under "What can I bring?" Please be aware that there are criminal and civil penalties for attempting to bring prohibited items through screening and you will also miss your trip.
